Acknowledgement of Risk

I agree to myself/my child to attend outdoor program run by YMCA Camp Kaitoke, to participate in outdoor activities.

I acknowledge that certain risks and hazards are inherent in outdoor activities and cannot be eliminated without destroying the unique character of the outdoors. However I understand that YMCA Camp Kaitoke will identify foreseeable risks or hazards and implement correct management strategies to eliminate, isolate or minimise those hazards. Our systems meet national guidelines.

I know that I am able to ask any questions about the activities I/my child will be involved in, to gain a better understanding of the risks involved.

I understand my child will participate in camp activities such as: abseiling, tramping, low ropes course, team building, swimming, kayaking, canoeing, archery, fire building, campfire cooking, orienteering, Giant Swing, Super Fox, games and sports, mudslide, flying fox, bush exploration, horse riding/handling.

Students may also sleep in tents.

The safety of each individual is of the utmost importance. I understand YMCA Camp Kaitoke may alter the program at any time, in order to ensure the safety and well-being of all participants. Substituted program will be more appropriate to the circumstances, and of similar worth.

I agree that Instructors & Camp Manager have the discretion to stand down students for repeated or severe misbehaviour during activities.

YMCA Camp Kaitoke and YMCA Greater Wellington are not responsible for loss, theft or damage to personal property.

Camp staff hold current first aid certification. There is no doctor on site.
