The day programmes run Monday to Friday from 8:30am–3:30pm. There is a main theme each day, and all programmes include activities such as sports, excursions, arts’n’crafts and child-centred play spaces provided to make the day interesting.

WHAT TO BRING**

- Water bottle

- Enough food for morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea
- Appropriate clothing and footwear for an active day.

YMCA SCHOLARSHIPS AND WINZ SUBSIDY

You may be eligible to receive a YMCA scholarship or WINZ subsidy towards the cost of our programmes. Scholarship forms are available on our website. WINZ forms will be emailed to you if you select the WINZ payment method in the shopping cart.

FEES

Holiday Programme Sick Fee - \$20 Due to illness. Child is absent from programme and is reported to the centre supervisor by 8.30am that day.

Casual booking fee - If notice of care is less than two full working days’ notice, it will incur a \$5 admin fee per session being booked.

Cancellation Notice –

If more than four calendar days’ notice or more is given, there will be no charge.

If less than four calendar days’ notice is given, there will still be a full charge.

Phone Fee - \$5 - If for any reason, a staff member needs to make a phone call to you, then you may be charged a phone fee in addition to any applicable fees.

Late pick up Fee - \$20 for the first 15 minutes, then \$1 for every minute thereafter per child.

** If your child arrives at the programme without the appropriate items, we may be unable to have them attend our programme until an acceptable solution is agreed upon.

Please note: We aim to follow our advertised programme and give acceptable notice of all changes to activities and programming. However, this is not always possible. Please understand activities may change without notice if circumstances demand. The YMCA is not obliged to offer any compensation for this occurring as limited numbers and other circumstances must be met to run all sessions.
